The North Edinburgh Path Network – QuietRoutes 11 – 15

Discover Edinburgh's northern quarter on fully signed and purpose-built paths. The network is a great way to commute to and from Edinburgh's West End in comfort and away from traffic. It is also a lovely leisure ride, or walk through wooded cuttings, and historic bridges and tunnels to places like the Royal Botanic Garden, Victoria Park and the Water of Leith.

Recent route improvements:

- Improved drainage and surfacing (further improvements are currently under design)
- All routes will be fully signed and numbered as QuietRoutes
- Annual September artwork exhibits and events at the Rodney Street Tunnel
- Five ways junction re-designed and landscaped with seating and signs.

QuietRoutes

The Council is developing a network of QuietRoutes, which are routes for everyone, on paths and low traffic roads. When completed they will provide convenient and high quality routes where users of all abilities can be confident of getting to where they want to go. Perfect for commuting in comfort and for trips out exploring Edinburgh.

Each route has a number and colour to help identify them on maps and signs. When complete, every route will have blue signs that indicate the route's number, colour, destinations and distances to help you find your way (see photo above right).



Leith Walk and the Restalrig Railpath

Leith Walk is undergoing major redesign with improved cycle facilities. Alongside this the fully signed, lit and surfaced Restalrig Railpath provides people in Leith and Restalrig with opportunities to get to Leith Academy, Lochend Park and the Promenade (via QuietRoute 10) away from traffic on a purpose built path.

Recent route improvements:

- Surfacing, lighting and signing of the Restalrig Railpath
- Redesign and ongoing upgrades of Leith Walk to provide better facilities for people on foot and by bike
- Widened and resurfaced paths in Leith Links and Seafield
- New and improved crossings and bridges.

ROUTES

- Main cycle path, wider, usually better surface
- Access points: level, ramp, steps
- Other cycle path, rough surface or narrower
- Short cut for cyclists, level, with steps
- Traffic-calmed road/ 20 mph zone
- Suggested quieter road link to cycle path
- Informal path
- FB Footbridge
- Main road (Fast or heavy traffic may make cycling conditions uncomfortable)
- Bus, taxi & cycle lane
- Cycle (only) lane
- Light-controlled pedestrian crossing (excluding traffic lights)
- Pedestrian and cycle crossing (Toucan)
- Tram, tram stop
- Railway, station
